Alison Campsie of *The Scotsman* recently highlighted an archaeological dig of Loch Lomond by Dr. Heather James of Calluna Archaeology. Dr. James was commissioned by Clan MacFarlane Worldwide to chart the changes of the territory over the centuries, during and since the zenith of the Clan in their ancestral lands.

While minimal information regarding the inhabitation of the area existed until this point, Dr. James intends to change that! Perhaps the overarching vision of this project was summed up best by Dr. James: “We are bringing these sites back into common knowledge. These lochs and glens were not empty. There were lots of people out there farming and using the landscape... This area certainly was a busy place. It strikes you as you walk through this landscape, there would have been lots of people and animals wandering about.”



# Ancient MacFarlane Island Stronghold in Loch Lomond?

The unexplored old foundations of a building on a secluded point of land in the head of Loch Lomond has been noticed and talked about for over three hundred years. It is located in the original arrochar of land given by a 1225 charter to Gilchrist, the 1<sup>st</sup> Baron of Arrochar. His great grandson, the Baron Parlan became the 1<sup>st</sup> Chief of MacFarlane in the 1300's.

This point of land is often an island when the Loch is high and it was clearly referred to by the 1600's historian and chief, Walter MacFarlane. In a transcription of his notes he is quoted; "...hard upon the head of the Loch is Ylen Eunlich of a flight shot long, with a dwelling upon it, it is a half mile





distant from Dow-vysk...the mouth thereof." The 'island' (Ylen) size and described location confirms it is this northerly point of land in the Loch.

A walkover in 2013 by Professor Chris Dalgleish suggested to him the exposed


foundation's use was for a Victorian fisherman's bothy, but which may have been built over older stonework.

The Clan MacFarlane Worldwide (CMW) continuing archaeological studies of their ancient Clan's arrochar of land now has taken the opportunity to professionally explore this last of the four 'MacFarlane Island Strongholds' in Loch Lomond. In the fall of 2018, a two-week archaeology dig of the site, funded by CMW will be carefully done by Dr Heather James of Calluna Archaeology, with all needed permissions.

As CMW has done for its previous studies, a final report will be made of the dig with all the findings. This will be published in appropriate places in Scotland, plus CMW's Facebook site and it's website at [http://www.clanmacfarlane.org/public\\_html/](http://www.clanmacfarlane.org/public_html/)

4. Nomination period for the upcoming election has come to a close. We will soon hear from our Election Director, Neal McFarland, regarding who the candidates are.




